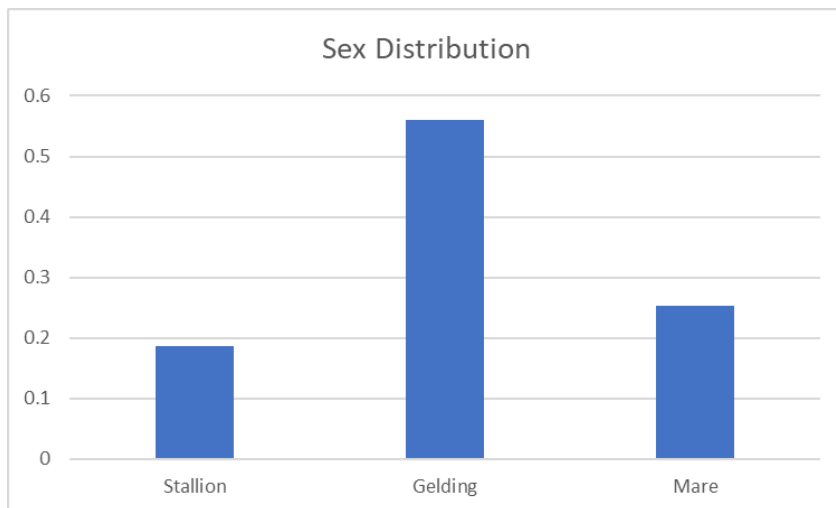

The top 75 horses on the Longines Combination in Jumping Rankings List that were 15 years or older at the time of competing were selected for this analysis. 1) *Below are the names of the 75 horses selected for inclusion in this analysis.*

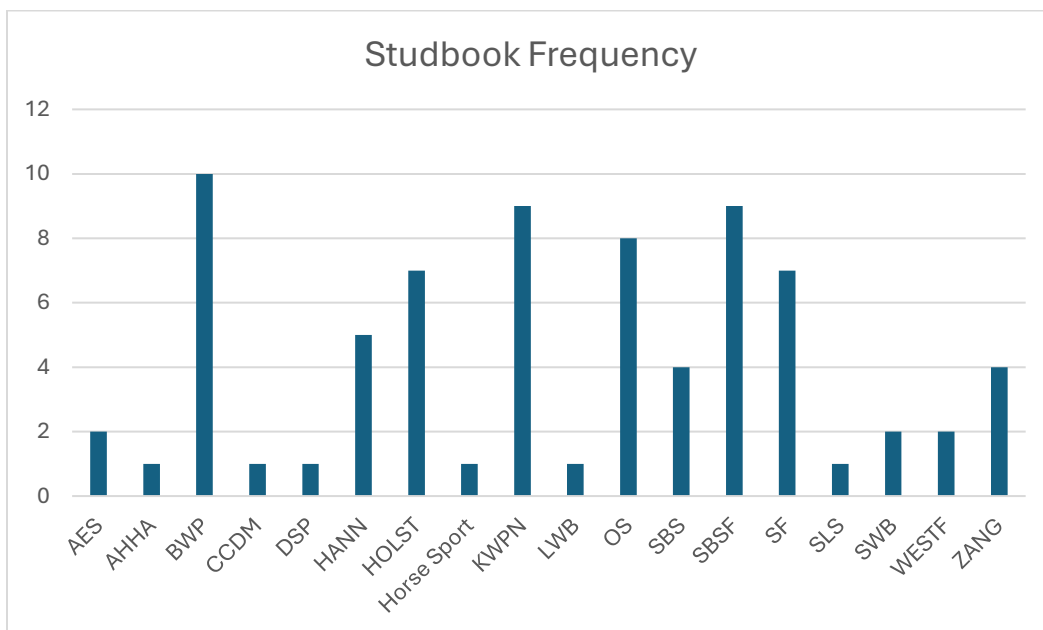

4) *The only breeder to appear more than once was Gestüt Lewitz (Shockemohle) – with 6 of their horses appearing on our list (CHACON 2, H5 CHAGANUS, H5 QUINTOL, TOULAGO, THE SINNER, BALOU DU REVENTON). Need to dive into this further to see if it is a numbers game or if their young horse program is legitimately sound.*

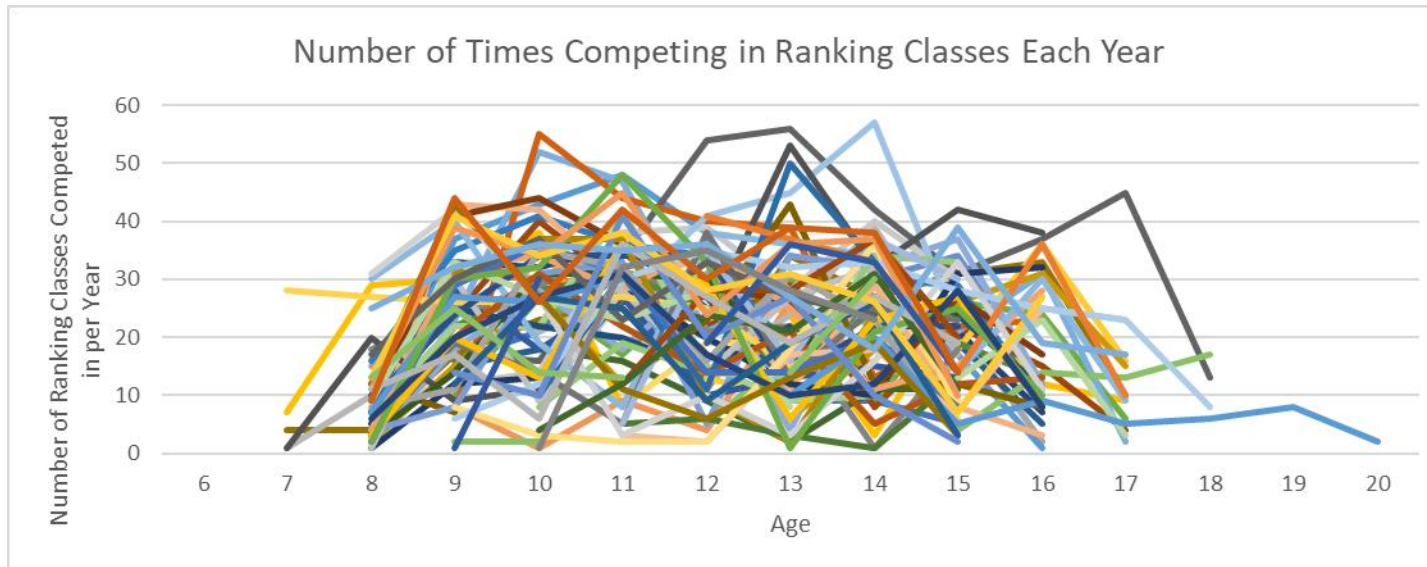
6) *Dam's Sires appearing more than once.*

7) *Unsurprisingly, no Dam appeared more than once.*

8) *The number of times each horse competed in ranking classes (for each year of their life) is shown below. A few trends stand out to me:*

- a. It is very rare for horses to maintain a high volume of classes year over year.
- b. It is common for horses that have longevity in the sport to have years where they don't compete often (whether that is due to an injury, changing riders, environmental constraints (e.g. COVID)). This is something to investigate further.
- c. It is rare for horses past the age of 17 to have much success in the sport (at least in this dataset).



9) *Peder Fredricson and Yuri Mansur both rode four different horses on our list.*

10) *A handful of horses have stayed with just one rider throughout their careers (Akunna Mattata, Babel, Blue Movie, Campari Z, H5 Quintol, Hermes Ryan, T'Obetty du Domaine, Utopie Villelongue)*

11) *Twenty-one of the horses competed at a World Games or Olympics*

12) *Every horse on the list jumped in 1.60m classes and their age during their first 1.60m class is shown below. The two 7-year-olds are Verdi and H5 Quintol (need to look into that more...)*
